Day Dockage

(Up to 3 hours, Including Tax, No Electric, No Amenity Access)

Daily Off Season & Peak Season Monday – Thursday	\$1/ft
Peak Season Friday – Sunday & Holidays	\$2/ft*

*If purchasing over 100 gallons of fuel, day dockage is \$1.50/ft

If purchasing over 150 gallons of fuel, day dockage is \$1/ft

Non-Commercial Pick Up/Drop Off (15 minutes): Flat Rate, Per touch. Under 50': \$35,
Over 50': \$45. Day dockage will be charged after 15 minutes.

Check In: After 1pm.

Check Out: By 11am. Departures after noon will be charged day dockage rates.

Deposits: Reservations require a one-night deposit upon booking.

Weekly Rate: Stay 7 nights, pay for 6 nights of dockage (electricity still charged).

Groups: Reservations booked as part of a group (5 or more boats) require a non-refundable one-night deposit to receive a 10% discount off dockage. The deposit is not returned, regardless of when the reservation is cancelled.

Cancellation Policy: 72-hour cancellation policy. If a reservation is cancelled prior to 72-hours of the reservation check-in time, the deposit is fully refunded. Cancellations within 72-hours of reservation result in dockage credit, except in case of Small Craft Advisory. Dockage credit is valid during the 2026 season.
